

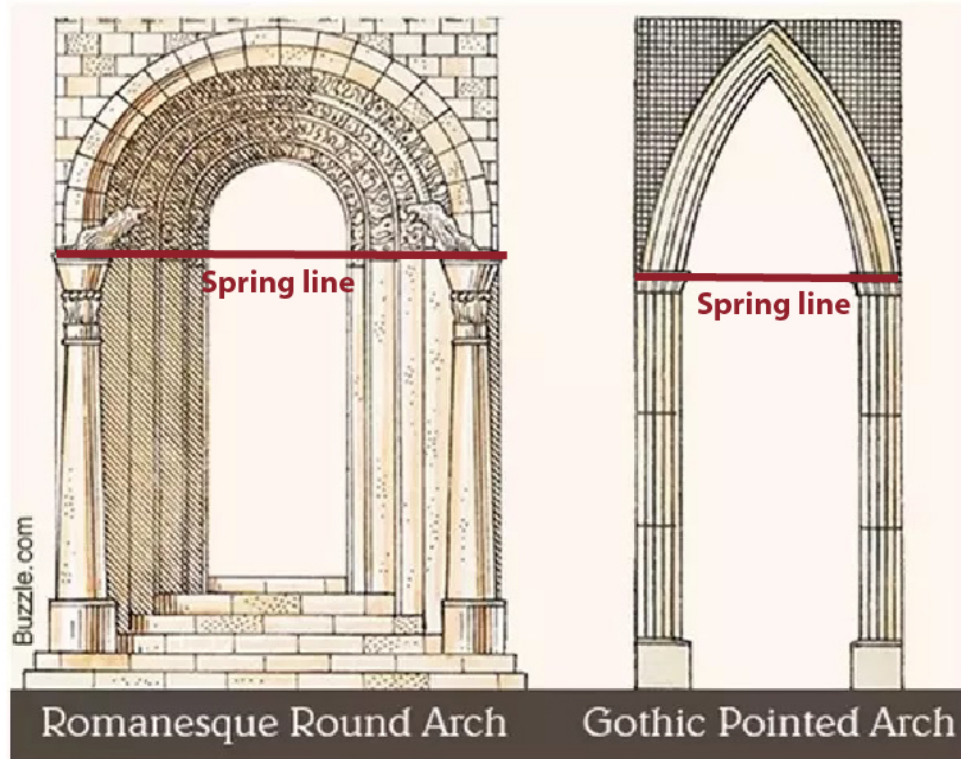
ARCHES -

There are two main types of arches and many variations of them. The round Roman arch and the pointed Gothic arch.

Both arches start on a vertical column. They begin to curve at a definite point called the **spring line**. When sketching a row of arches it is important to align the spring lines to a perspective guide line.

Round arches in perspective Form:

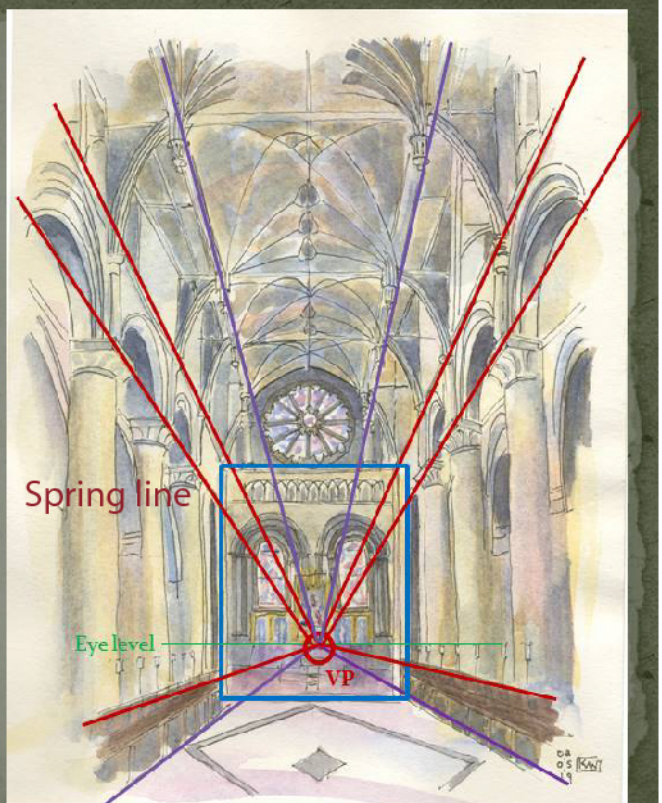


Elliptical arches

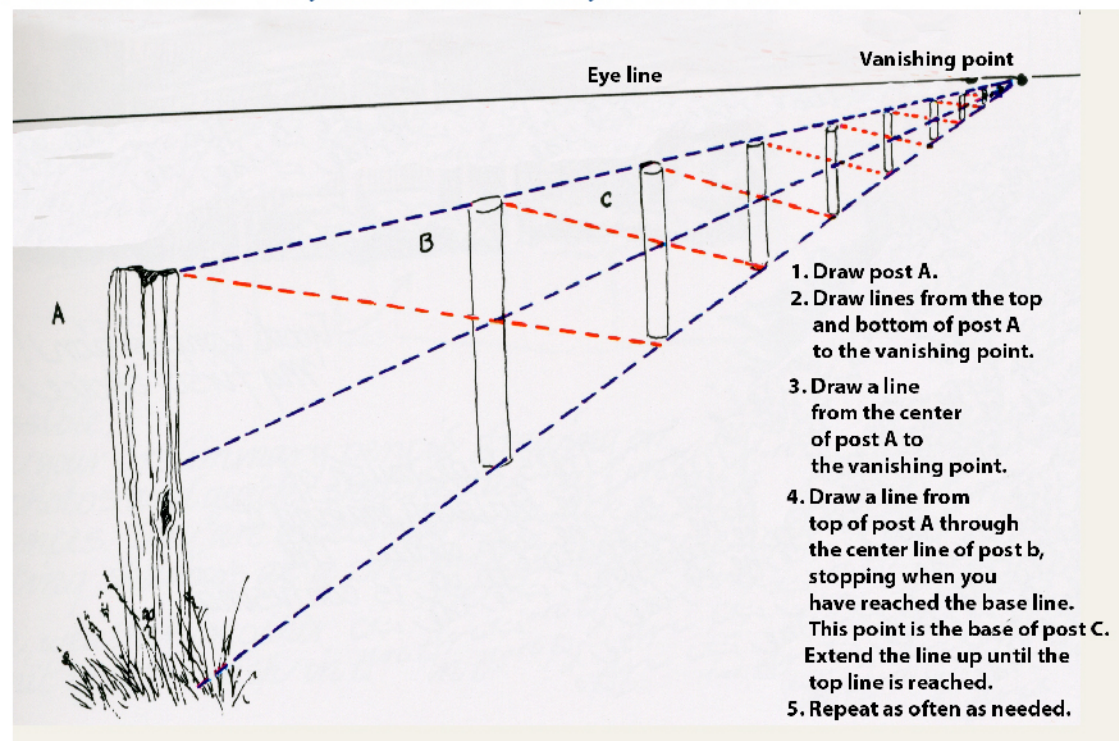
- 1- point perspective

Construction steps:

1. Find eye level and vanishing point.
2. Draw the back wall. Keep it low on the page.
3. Mark eye level and vanishing point.
4. Draw perspective guides at top of arch, spring line, bottom of arch.
5. Draw perspective guides for ceiling and floor levels.
6. Place ellipses and begin drawing.



POSTS AND ARCHES IN PERSPECTIVE

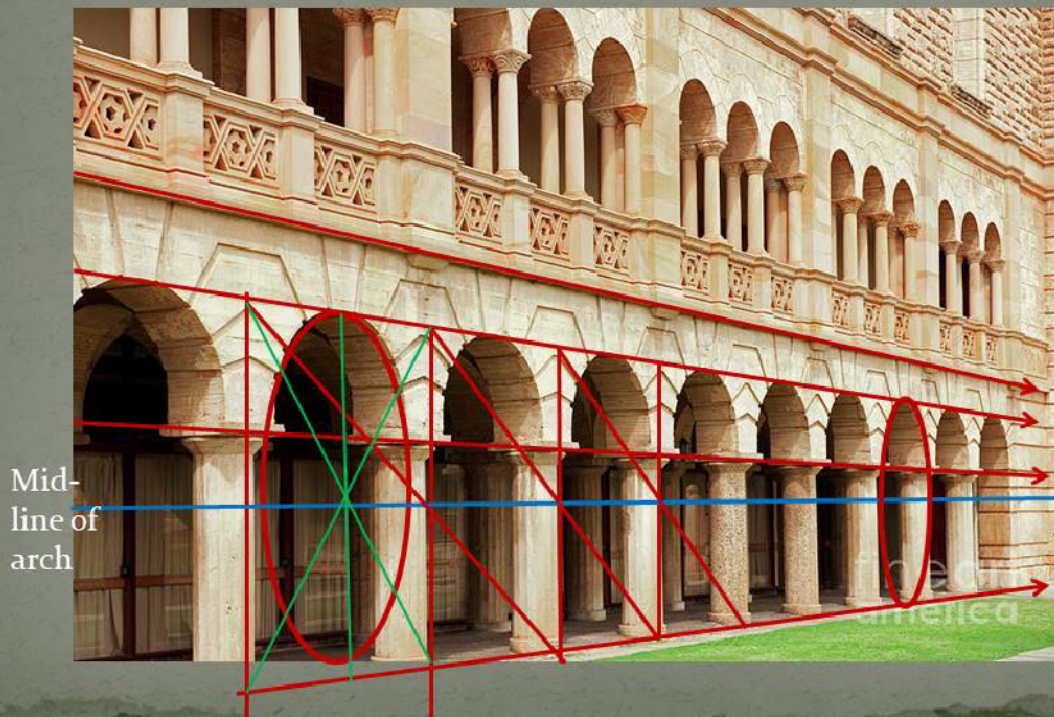


Elliptical arches – Arches in 2-point perspective

Draw perspective lines through:

1. Top of arch
2. Spring of arch.
3. Bottom of arch.
4. Mid-line of arch.

- Ellipses get smaller and narrower as they recede.



ABSTRACTING COMPLEX OBJECTS -

Steps to reducing detail.

- 1.) Draw a basic outline. Squinting helps.**
- 2.) Draw the shapes of the larger and darkest shadows.**
- 3.) Draw the highlights.**
- 4.) Squint and add a very few additional lines (very sketchy).**
- 5.) 30% of what you see is enough to be convincing and readable.**

Payne's grey direct watercolor with a waterbrush. 10 minutes.

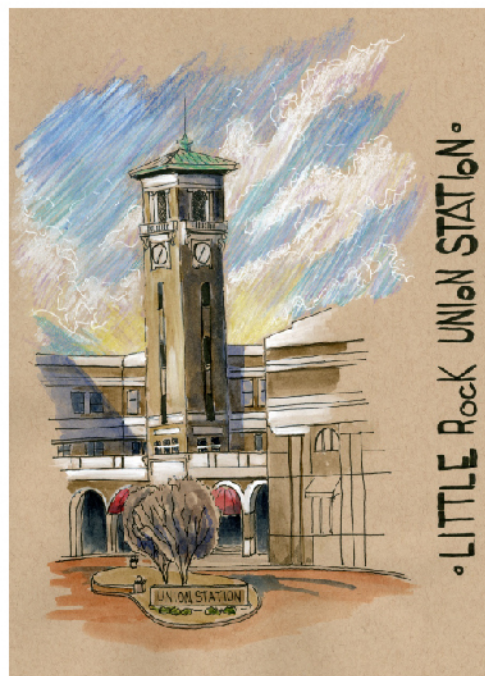


Pilot V5 rollerball pen and a waterbrush. 10 minutes.

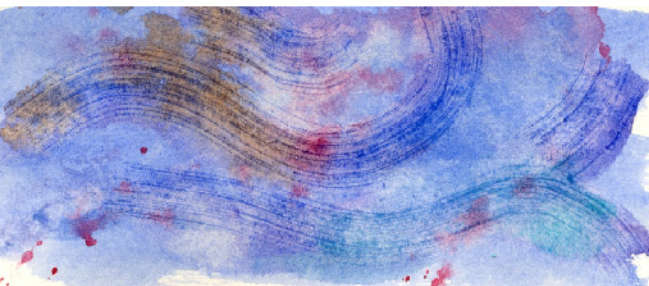
ATMOSPHERICS -



Colored skies - can be any color.



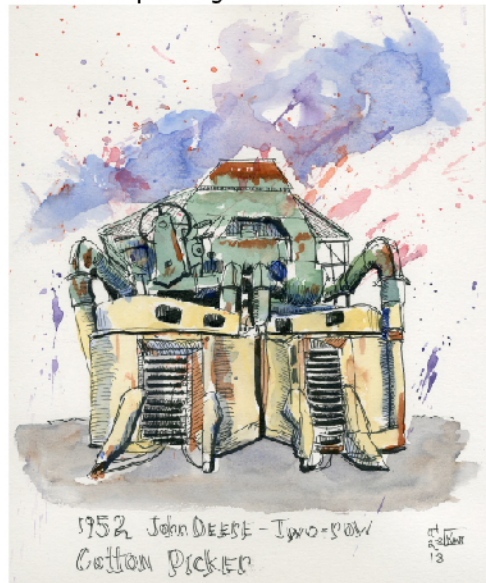
Pencil stroke, Gel pen or line -
Adds vigor to your sketch.



Scraping with sandpaper - Quickly adds random line for wood, vegetation and skies.



Sparkle - small spots of color used to enliven a painting.



Spatter - use for texture, interest, excitement. Choose colors that compliment the painting in color or mood.



Cailiflowers or blooms - add interest and spontaneity and can suggest clouds or other elements.
