

The group visited the author's gravesite, explored the archives of the University of Mississippi Library, toured Rowan Oak (Faulkner's beautifully restored home), and walked through the historic neighborhood described in many of Faulkner's books. The trip also included a stop in Square Books, a famous independent bookstore on the square and an excellent dinner at McEwen's Restaurant with host, Meg DuChaine, Faulkner's great-niece.
